

Girls Ministries Code of Conduct

The Girls Clubs are biblically based

Girls who choose to become part of the clubs, must understand and adhere to the scriptural admonition for Christian character and conduct set forth in the stated Code of Conduct.

The clubs serve three functions — relationship building, character development, and Christian discipleship

The wise leader understands her role and responsibility to cultivate these three aspects of each girl's life by fulfilling the third point of the fivefold purpose — providing accountability

Code of Conduct Form

- Sponsors should inform girls' parents of the Girls Ministries Code of Conduct requirements
- The Code of Conduct form should be signed by girls in Stars, Friends, and Girls Only Club members as they begin each club or at the point of salvation as a symbolic act of accountability
- Upholding the Code of Conduct is a requirement for receiving any honor awards with or without the signed form
- Leaders should file signed forms in the girls' folders
- Copies of the forms are located in the Reproducible pages of each Sponsor Guide (on CD Rom) as well as the Coordinator's Guide
